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Parent management training refers to a treatment in which parents are trained to interact with the child in ways that promote prosocial behavior. The treatment focuses on the use of reinforcement (e.g., praise, tokens), mild punishment (e.g., brief time out, response cost), and related techniques (e.g., prompting, shaping) to develop child behavior.
