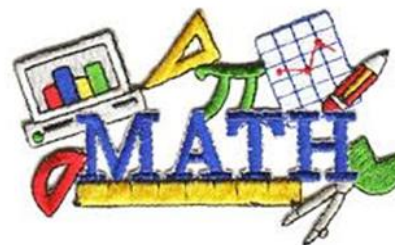
This half-day training is for teams of 2 or 3 people including an administrator, curriculum specialist and math teacher. The training is designed to give a high-level overview of the IMET.

The Math IMET is a comprehensive tool to help educators determine whether instructional materials are aligned to the shifts and major features of the Common Core State Standards (CCSS). The substantial instructional shifts at the heart of the Common Core State Standards are:

- Focus: Focus strongly where the standards focus.
- Coherence: Think across grades and link to major topics within the grade.
- Rigor: In major topics, pursue conceptual understanding, procedural skill and fluency, and application with equal intensity.

The IMET can be used to:

- Inform decisions about purchasing instructional materials
- Evaluate previously purchased materials to identify necessary modifications
- Build understanding of what aligned materials look like
