In support of the recommendations in the Commissioner's Council on Mathematics Report, the Connecticut State Department of Education, in partnership with PIMMS at Wesleyan University, is offering the Intel® Math Program for K-8 teachers. This content-intensive professional development program provides 80 hours of professional development in mathematics. The course places emphasis on deepening the teacher participants' understanding of core K-8 mathematics concepts and vertical progressions. It is grounded in a problem-solving approach to topics such as integer arithmetic, the decimal number system, place value, rational number arithmetic, rates, linear equations, and functions. Intel Math is a content course for the teacher as the learner.
